IPL Play of the Day: Mitchell Starc comes clutch to rip the life out of Rajasthan

IPL 2026, DC vs RR: Mitchell Starc rattled Rajasthan Royals with a sensational over in which he picked up three wickets, laying the foundation for Delhi Capitals' five-wicket win on Sunday at the Arun Jaitley Stadium in New Delhi.

New Delhi. (Agency) They say T20 matches can turn in the space of a few overs, but on Sunday, Mitchell Starc produced one over that completely changed the game on its head. Delhi Capitals beat Rajasthan Royals by five wickets, but the victory may not have been possible had Starc not stepped up at the crucial moment. Without Starc, the Capitals could already have been knocked out of the competition, left to play only for pride for the remainder of

the tournament. With the Royals blazing along at 160 for two in 14 overs, they looked well on course to reach a total in the region of 240. Instead, they failed to even cross the 200-run mark, eventually managing only 193 for eight. The man responsible for that dramatic turnaround was Starc, who broke the Royals' back by taking three wickets in the 15th over. That spell completely derailed Rajasthan's innings, leaving them with little chance of recovering. Starc finished with superb figures of 4-0-40-4 and was deservedly named Player of the Match. Having played enough cricket at the highest level, stepping up in moments of crisis has almost become second nature to him. He has done it time and again for Australia, played a massive role in helping Kolkata Knight Riders win the IPL title in 2024, and is now once again showcasing his class for the Capitals.

HOW MITCHELL STARC ROCKED THE ROYALS
When Riyan Parag took Mukesh Kumar for 23 runs in the 12th over, scoring runs looked far



too easy for the Royals. However, Starc pulled things back brilliantly for the Capitals, with Rajasthan managing only 33 runs in the last six overs while losing six wickets in the

process. The 15th over began with Dhruv Jurel collecting a single to deep midwicket, but what followed was pure destruction. On the very next delivery, Starc removed the dangerous Parag, who had smashed 51 off just 26 balls. Starc cleverly rolled his fingers over an off-speed delivery, forcing Parag into a mistimed slog that was brilliantly caught by Axar Patel running in from long-on. The carnage continued immediately as Donovan Ferreira walked in and departed for a golden duck. Starc banged in a short-of-length delivery outside off, Ferreira attempted an ambitious heave first ball, but once again Axar Patel completed the catch in the deep. Although Ravi Singh denied Starc a hat-trick with a boundary through midwicket, the Australian had the final word. Slipping in another slower delivery, Starc trapped Ravi Singh plumb lbw as HawkEye confirmed three reds.

CSK vs SRH Preview: MS Dhoni's potential farewell masks playoff qualification drama in Chennai

New Delhi. (Agency) Chennai Super Kings are set to play their final home game of the Indian Premier League 2026 season. It is arguably their most important game of the campaign, against SunRisers Hyderabad, as a loss would almost certainly knock them out of the playoff race. Having said that, the result itself might not be the biggest story heading into the game. With CSK playing their final home fixture of the season, almost all the focus is on Mahendra Singh Dhoni and whether he will feature against SunRisers Hyderabad. The speculation comes from the promise Dhoni has repeatedly made over the last few years: that he would play his final T20 game in Chennai, in front of the passionate fans at the MA Chidambaram Stadium. That possibility has completely changed the mood around the fixture. In a season filled with injuries and strains, Dhoni has played hide-and-seek with the

fans. After injuring his calf at the start of IPL 2026, he largely stayed away from the limelight. On multiple occasions this season, reports emerged from the CSK camp suggesting that the legendary captain was perfectly fine physically but was



choosing to stay away in order to provide opportunities to younger players who could become the core of the franchise in the coming years. And truthfully, that transition has already started to show signs of rebuilding.

This season has seen players like Kartik Sharma, Urvil Patel and Ramakrishna Ghosh step up for the side. Alongside the likes of Ayush Mhatre, Dewald Brevis and Noor Ahmad, CSK appear to be building a young core that could keep the franchise competitive in the near future.

But the final home game of the season changes all of that. The fans want Dhoni. The fans need Dhoni.

More than anything else, they want clarity. Has Dhoni already played his final IPL game? Will he return next season? Or will one of the most iconic careers in Indian cricket quietly come to an end without a farewell on the field?

With Suresh Raina arriving in Chennai ahead of the fixture, the rumours around Dhoni's final appearance have only grown stronger over the last 48 hours. And yet, beneath all the emotion, there remains a serious cricketing question for CSK to answer. This is still a must-win game.

IPL chairman Arun Dhimal interview: Leagues over bilaterals, real life over reels

Dharamsala. (Agency) The mountains do not care about the IPL. They sit behind the HPCA Stadium in Dharamsala the way they always have, enormous, indifferent, white-tipped, while below them ten franchises and their billions of dollars and their social media controversies play out across two months of Indian summer. It is a good place, then, to find some perspective. Arun Singh Dhimal is in his office at the stadium, and he is in no hurry. He leans back, he smiles often, he pauses before answering in the way that people do when they have actually thought about something rather than just rehearsed a line. He is the chairman of the Indian Premier League, the second most valuable sports league in the world, a tournament whose two franchise sales in a single March week, Royal Challengers Bengaluru at \$1.78

billion and Rajasthan Royals at \$1.63 billion, made front pages well beyond the sports desk. He is also the younger brother of Anurag Thakur, the former BCCI president and Union Cabinet minister, and



the son of Prem Kumar Dhimal, twice Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh. Cricket and politics and administration are, for him, not separate worlds. They are simply the air he has breathed since boyhood.

He grew up in Jalandhar, at a school that produced half the Punjab Ranji Trophy team. His cousins played Duleep Trophy and Ranji Trophy cricket. His brother Anurag played India Under-15 and Under-19. Arun captained the cricket team at his engineering college and played for his university. The love for the game was never in doubt. The path into administration came later, circuitously, as these things often do, through eligibility rules and Supreme Court orders and the particular accidents of timing that shape careers.

He became HPCA president, then resigned within 10 days to contest the BCCI treasurer's election in 2019, which he won. He grew the BCCI treasury by Rs 6,000 crore between 2019 and 2022. When the IPL chairmanship came up, it was first offered to Sourav Ganguly, who declined. Dhimal stepped in. He has not looked back.

Elina Svitolina wins Italian Open, Gael Monfils bursts with pride: What a woman



Dharamsala. (Agency) Elina Svitolina scripted one of the most emotional triumphs of her career after winning the 2026 Italian Open title in Rome, and no one appeared prouder than her husband, Gael Monfils. Moments after Svitolina's stunning victory, Monfils shared a heartfelt tribute on social media that instantly resonated with tennis fans around the world.

On Saturday, Svitolina defeated Coco Gauff in a gripping three-set final, winning 6-4, 6-7(3), 6-2 to reclaim the clay-court title after an eight-year wait. Monfils also praised Svitolina's resilience and strength throughout her comeback journey after motherhood, adding that she continues to inspire him every single day. "Eight years. Eight years to climb back to the top of a Masters 1000. What a season, what a week, what a player. But above all, what a woman. An incredible mom to Skai, an exceptional athlete, a soul like no other," Monfils wrote. "I'm so proud of you, my love. Of your strength, your calm, of everything you carry quietly day after day. You inspire me, every single day. Enjoy this, soak it all in. You deserve every second of it. I love you," Monfils added. Svitolina's victory in Rome marked a remarkable milestone in her career. After becoming a mother in 2022 and battling injuries in recent seasons, the Ukrainian has fully re-established herself among the elite players on the WTA Tour. She also secured her first WTA 1000 title since giving birth to her daughter while ending an eight-year wait between her Rome crowns.

HOW SVITOLINA DEFEATED GAUFF Against Gauff, Svitolina began aggressively, using her movement and defensive skills to frustrate Gauff in long rallies before taking the opening set 6-4. Gauff fought back strongly in the second set and forced a tiebreak, where the American raised her level to push the contest into a decider. However, Svitolina completely dominated the third set with her consistency from the baseline and ability to absorb pressure before counterattacking at the right moments.
